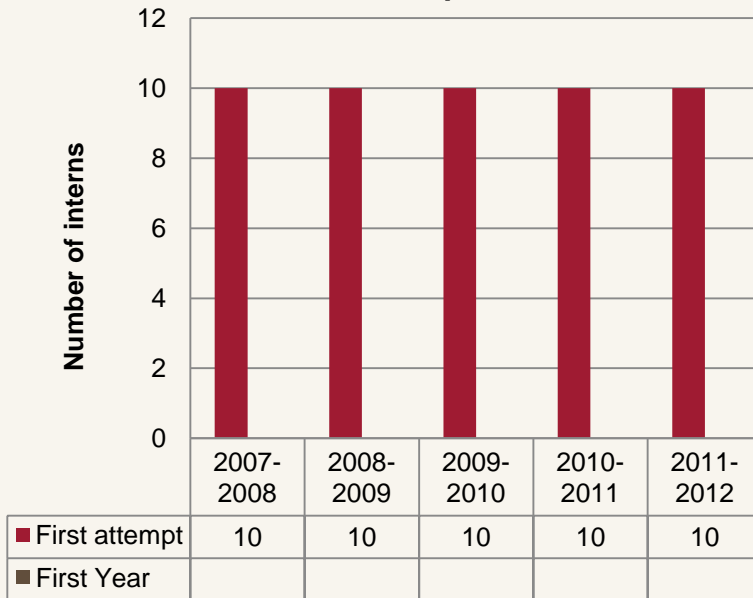
Objective 1.1:

Over a 5 year period, 85% of the graduates of the program will have passed the RD exam in the first attempt

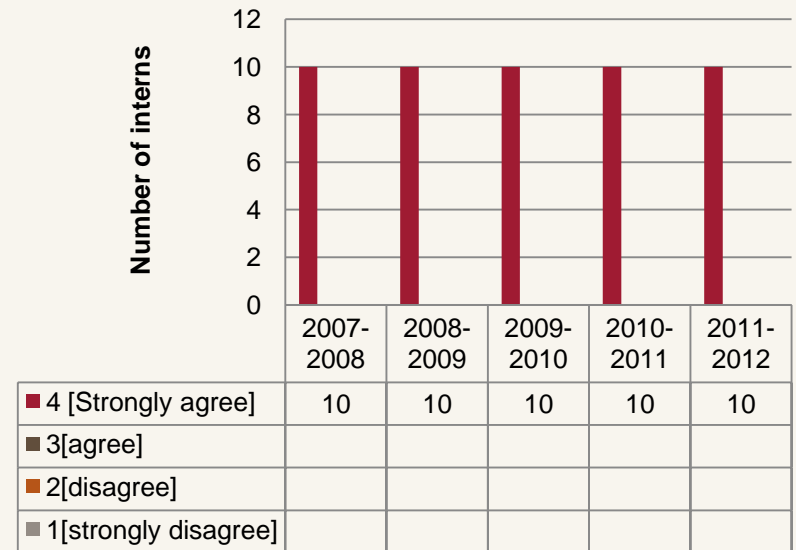
Objective 1.2:

First time pass rate



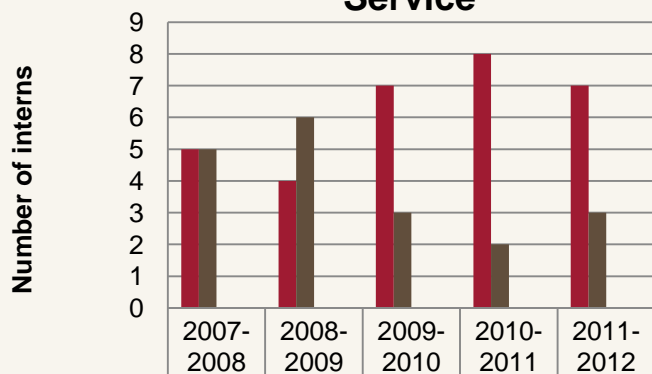
Program provided adequate knowledge and training in MNT



Objective 1.3:

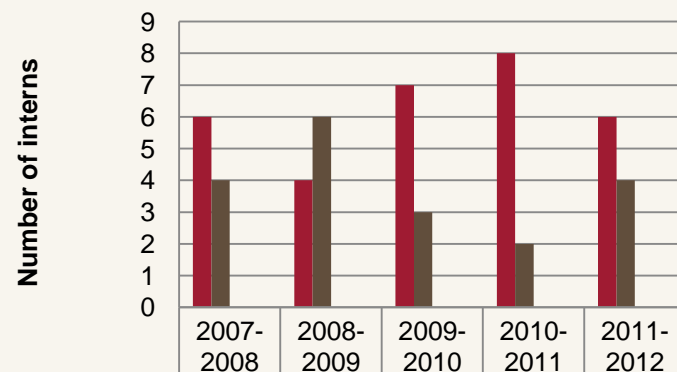

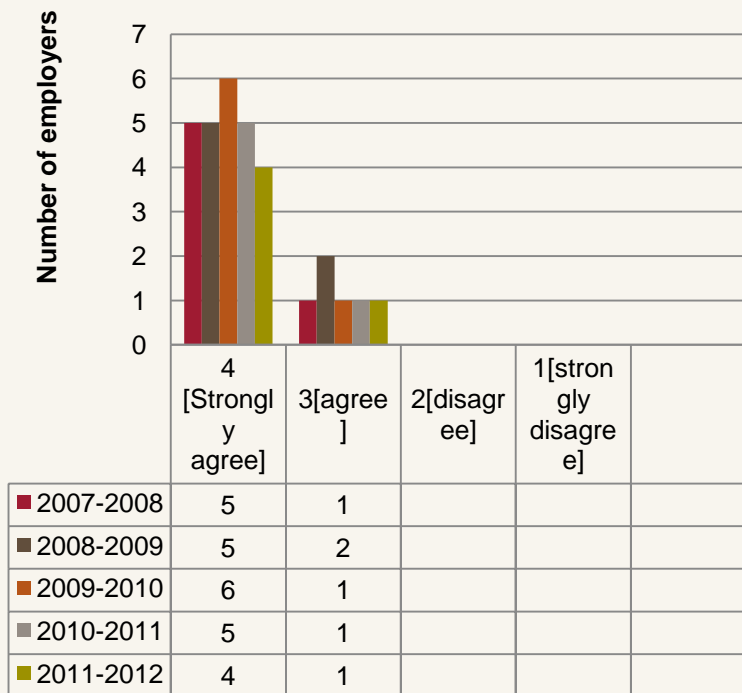

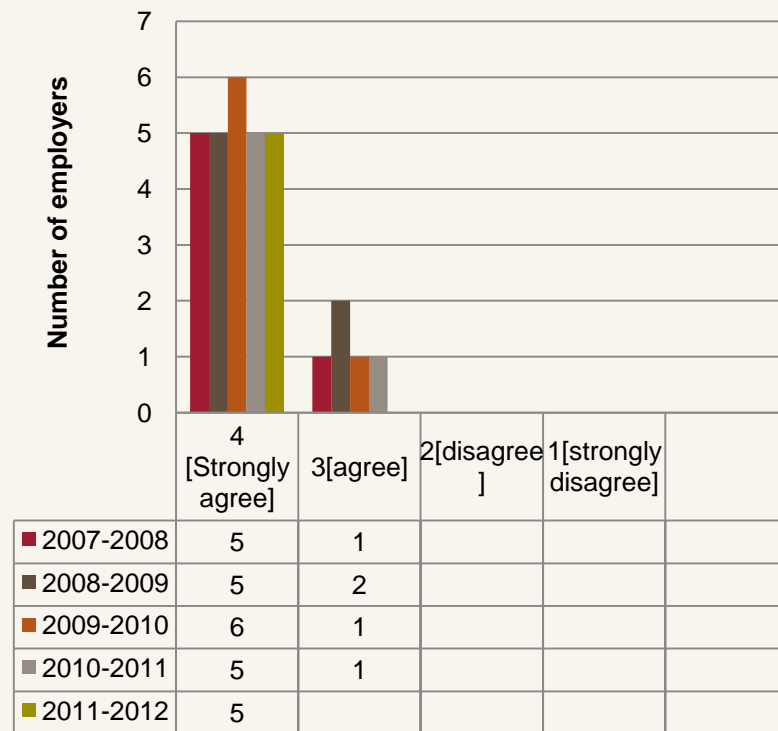
Employers rating the competency and skills of graduates



Objective 1.5:

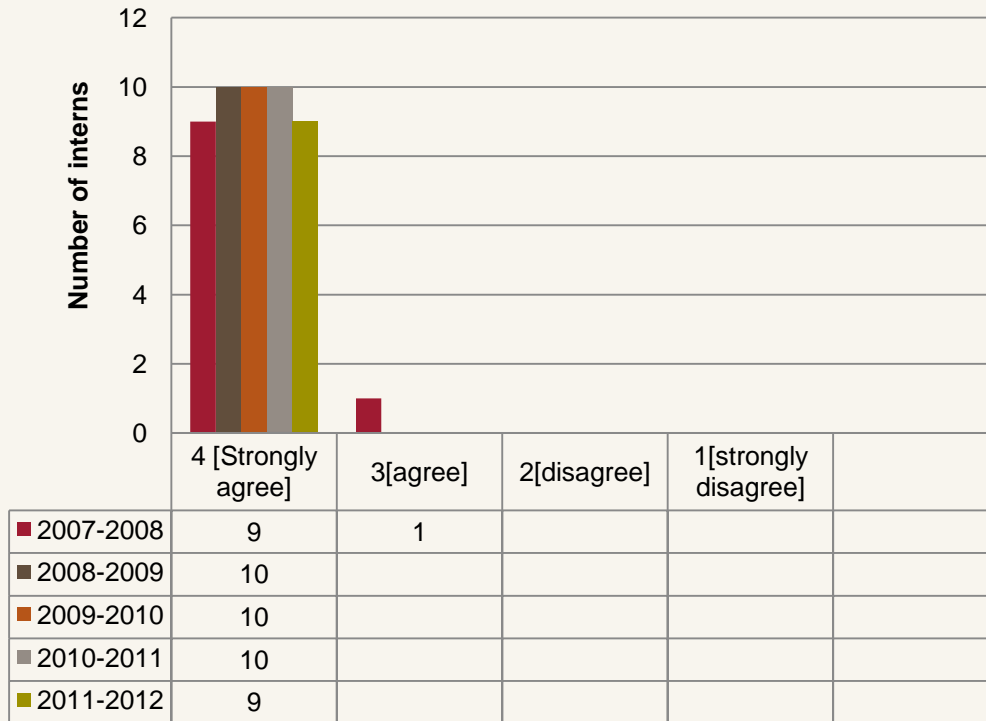

Program prepared me to work as a competent entry level RD



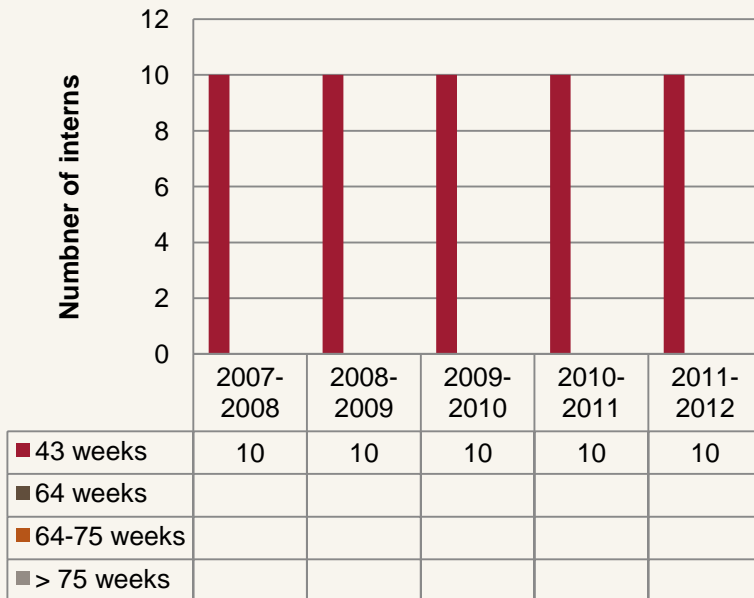
Goal 2

The program will prepare its graduates to meet the employment, health and nutritional needs of the communities they serve.

Objective 2.1

Over a 5 year period, 90% of the graduates would have completed all the program requirements within 150% of the time planned for completion [1.5 x 43= 64 weeks]

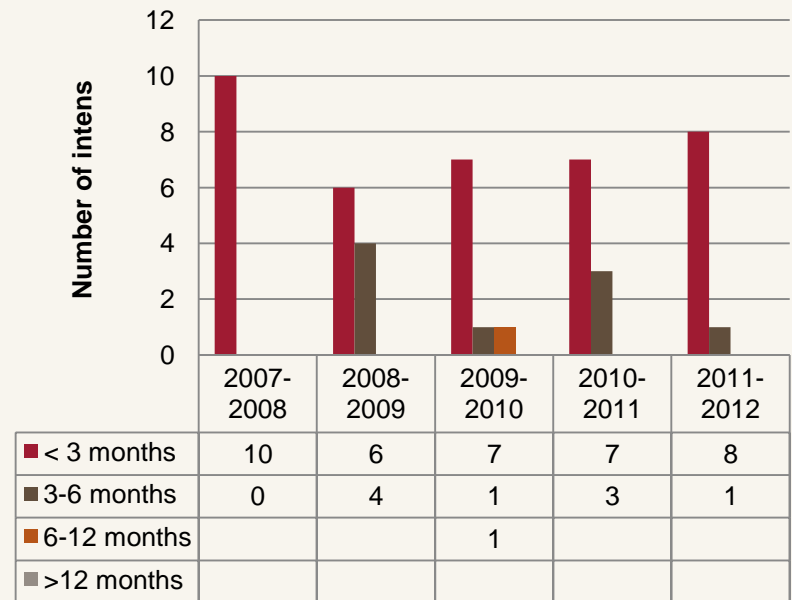
Program Completion

Over a 5 year period, 90% of the graduates seeking employment straight out of the internship, will be employed in dietetics or related fields within 12 months of graduation

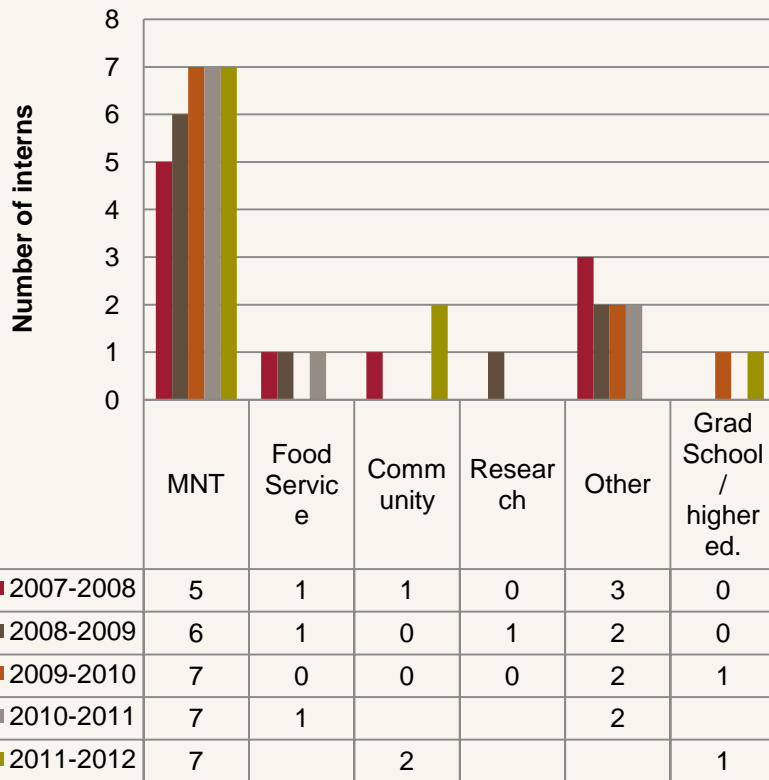
Time taken to find employment



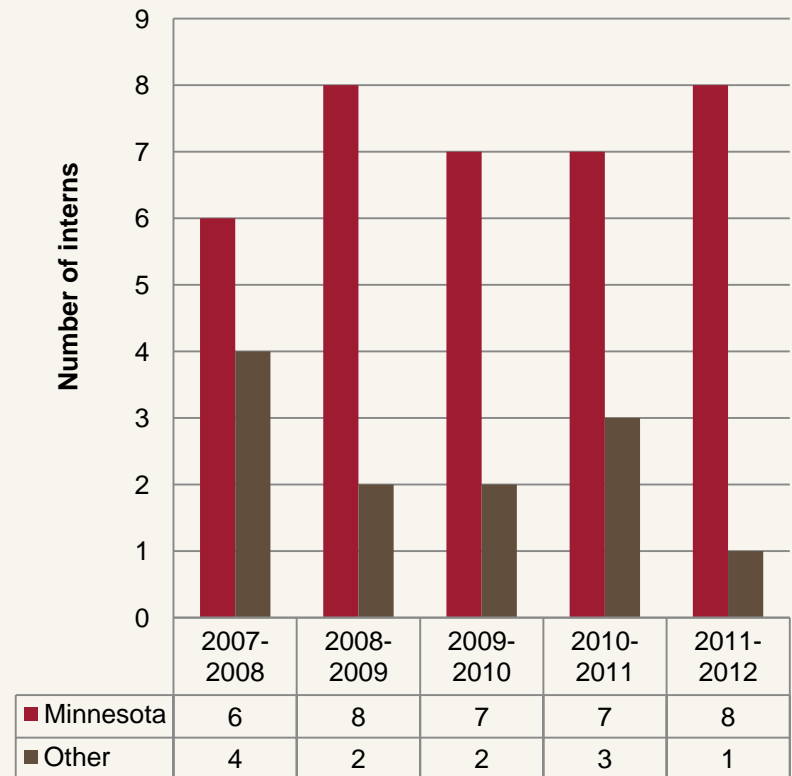
Objective 2.3 Over a 5 year period, 50% of the graduates seeking employment straight out of the internship, will be employed in the area of MNT

Area of employment



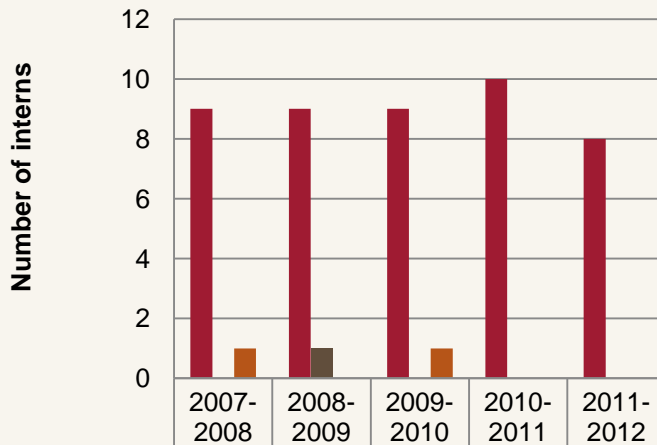
Employed in MN



Objective 2.5 Over a 5 year period, 75% of employed alumni will be employed in dietetics or related fields

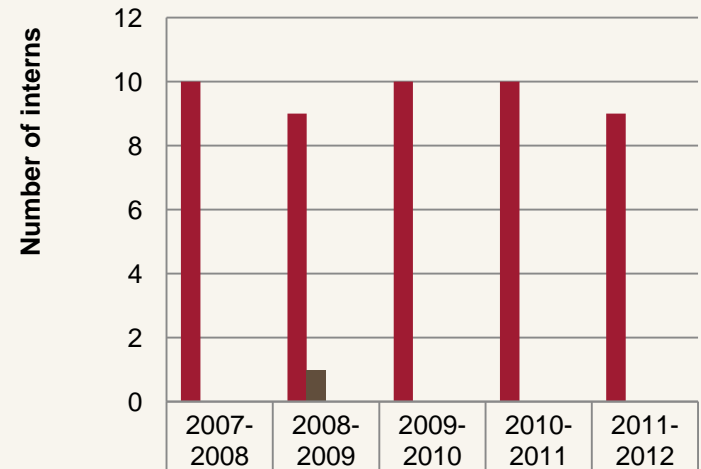

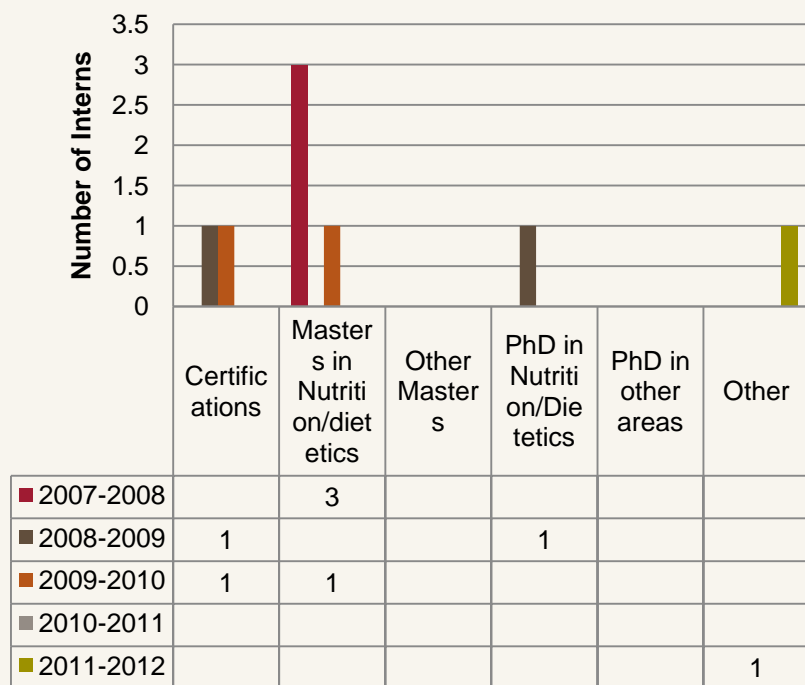
Goal 3

The program will advise, refer and encourage graduates to advance their learning and participate in leadership activities

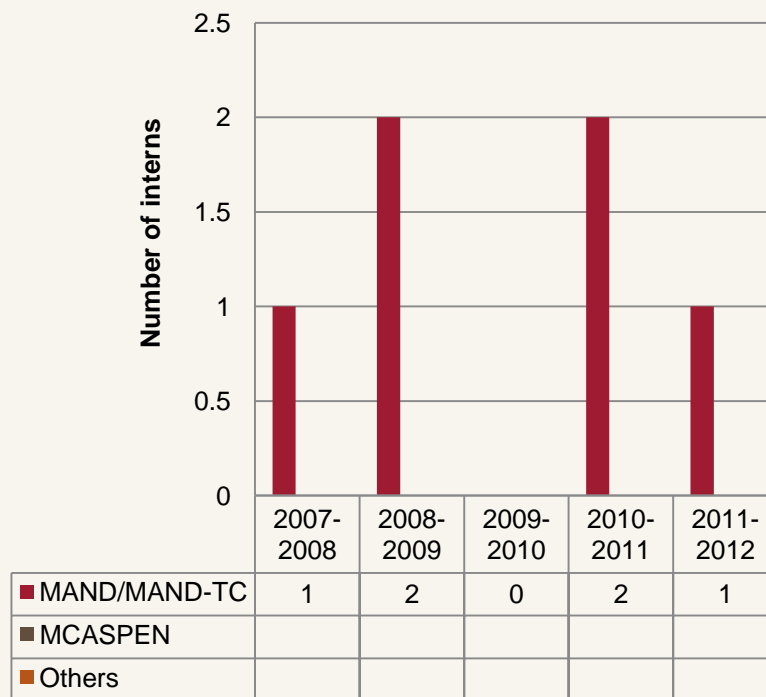

Leadership Positions



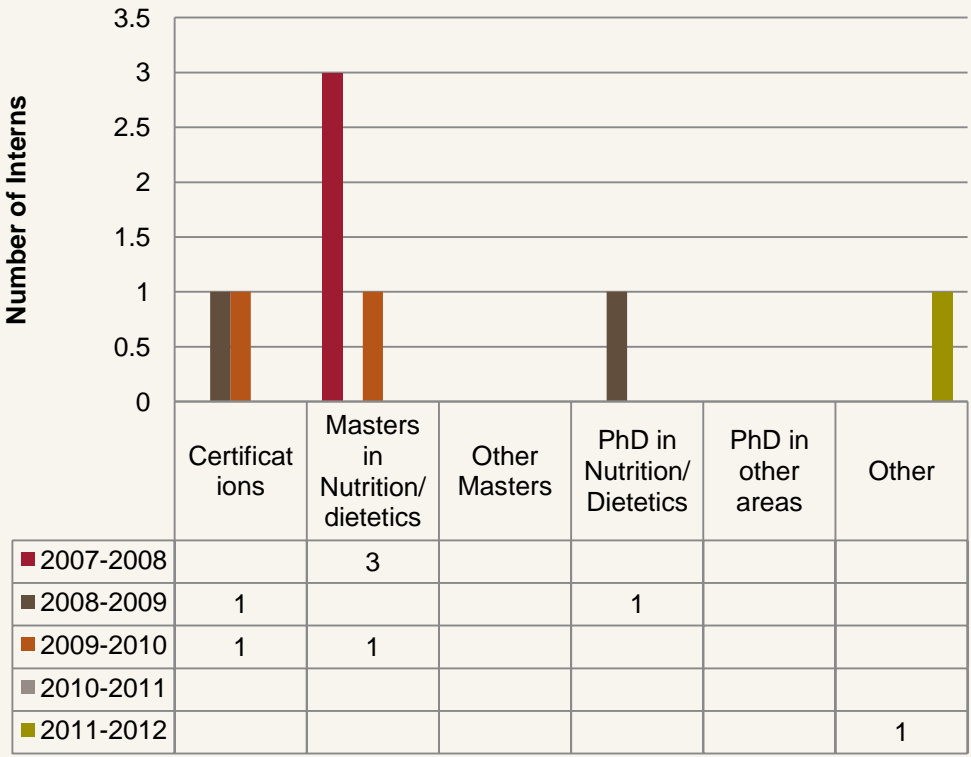
Goal 3
